### Pre-Anaesthetic Blood Tests

Regardless of the age of your pet, anaesthetic safety can always be enhanced by a more in depth understanding of the patient's health. Many disorders of the liver, kidneys, or blood, particularly in the early stages, cannot be detected without blood testing or may be exacerbated by anaesthesia. These can adversely affect patient safety & compromise patient recovery. Such tests are therefore particularly important before any kind of surgery and are highly recommended

### Intravenous Fluid Therapy

Receiving IV Fluids whilst under anaesthesia greatly enhances patient safety by supporting blood pressure to vital organs.

### Home Care Pain Relief

To ensure maximum comfort & a smooth recovery from surgery your pet can be sent home with oral liquid or tablet medications for pain relief
